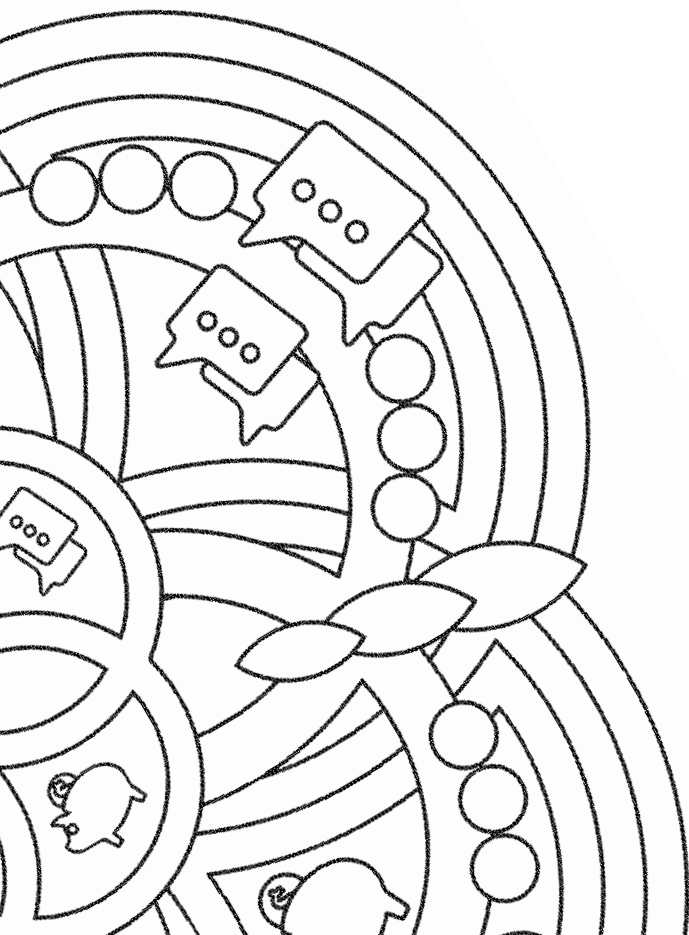


## HOW TO USE THESE ILLUSTRATIONS

The illustrations can be used as a collection or separate to stimulate discussions about sustainable development. They can also be used as a regular colouring book with beautiful illustrations.

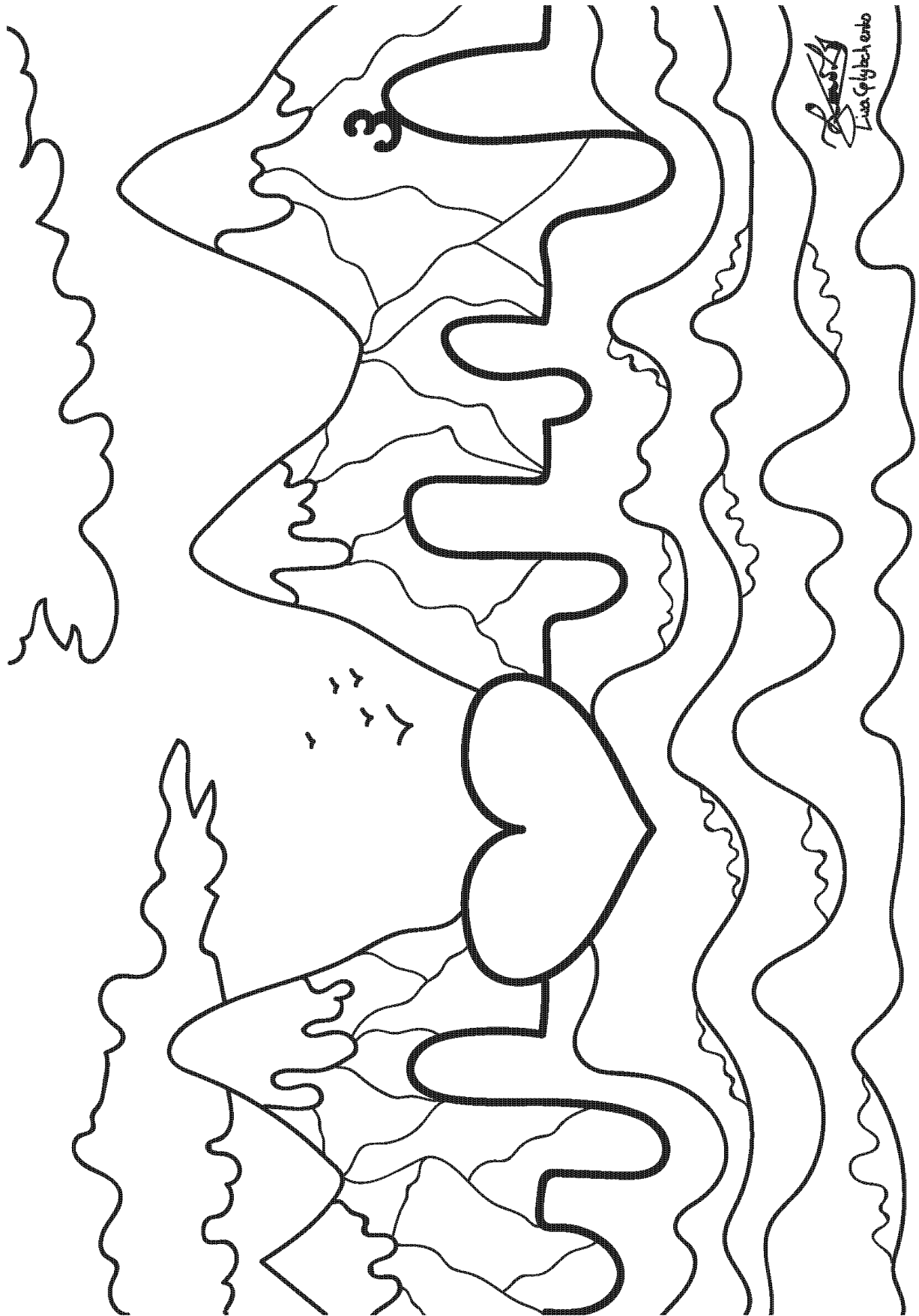
Use your creativity and come up with your own version of the illustrations. All illustrations feature the number of the goal its representing.







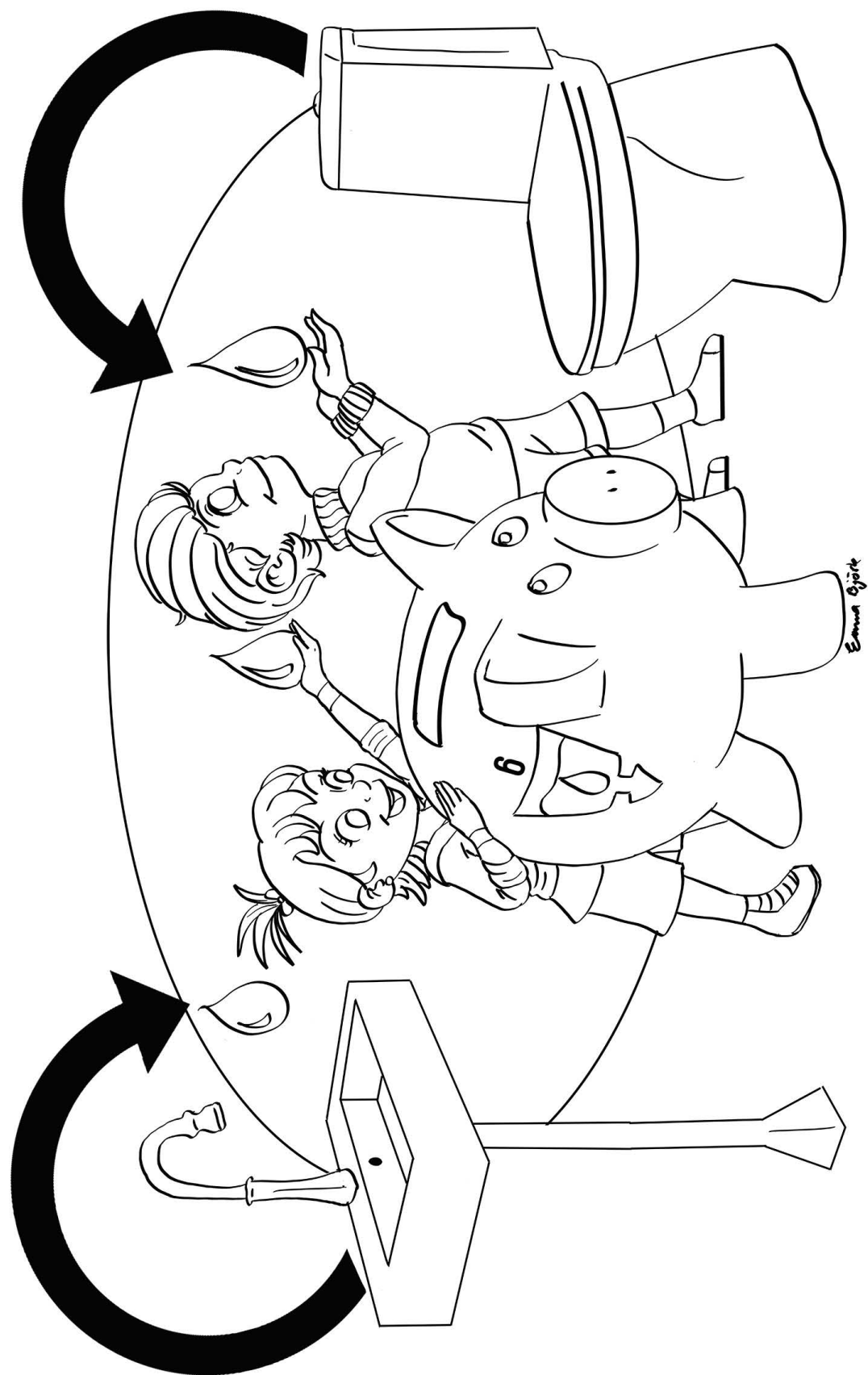


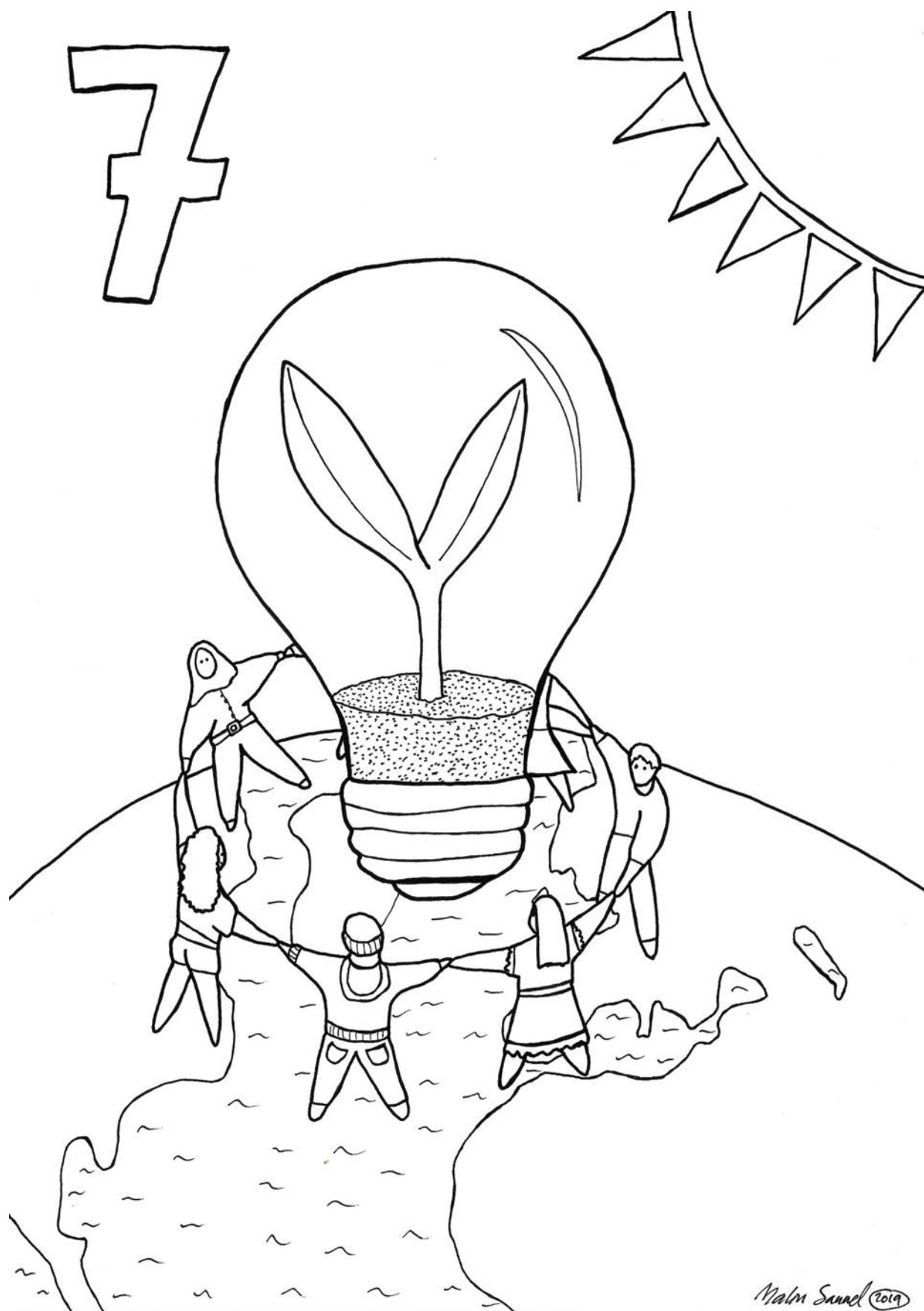


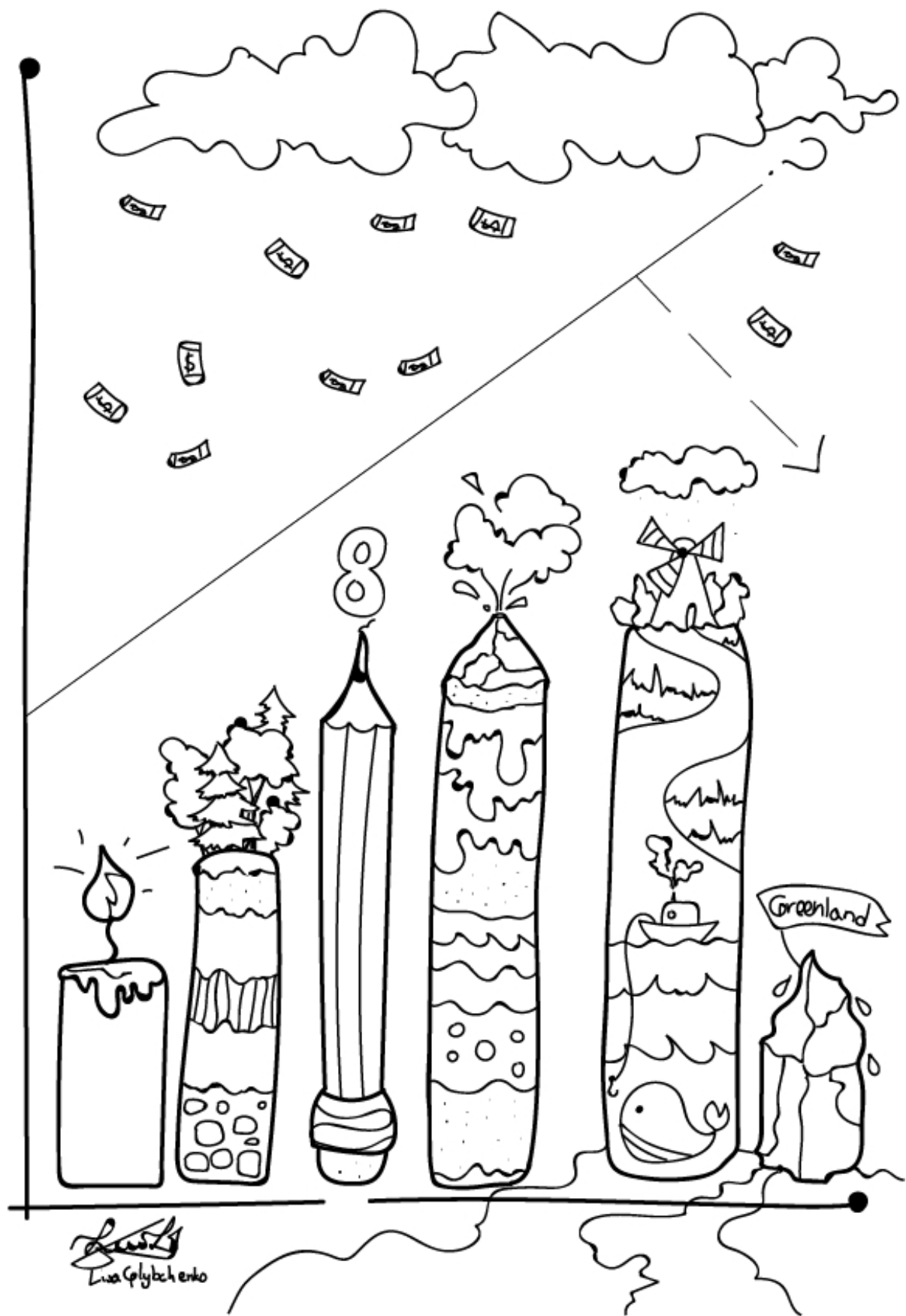


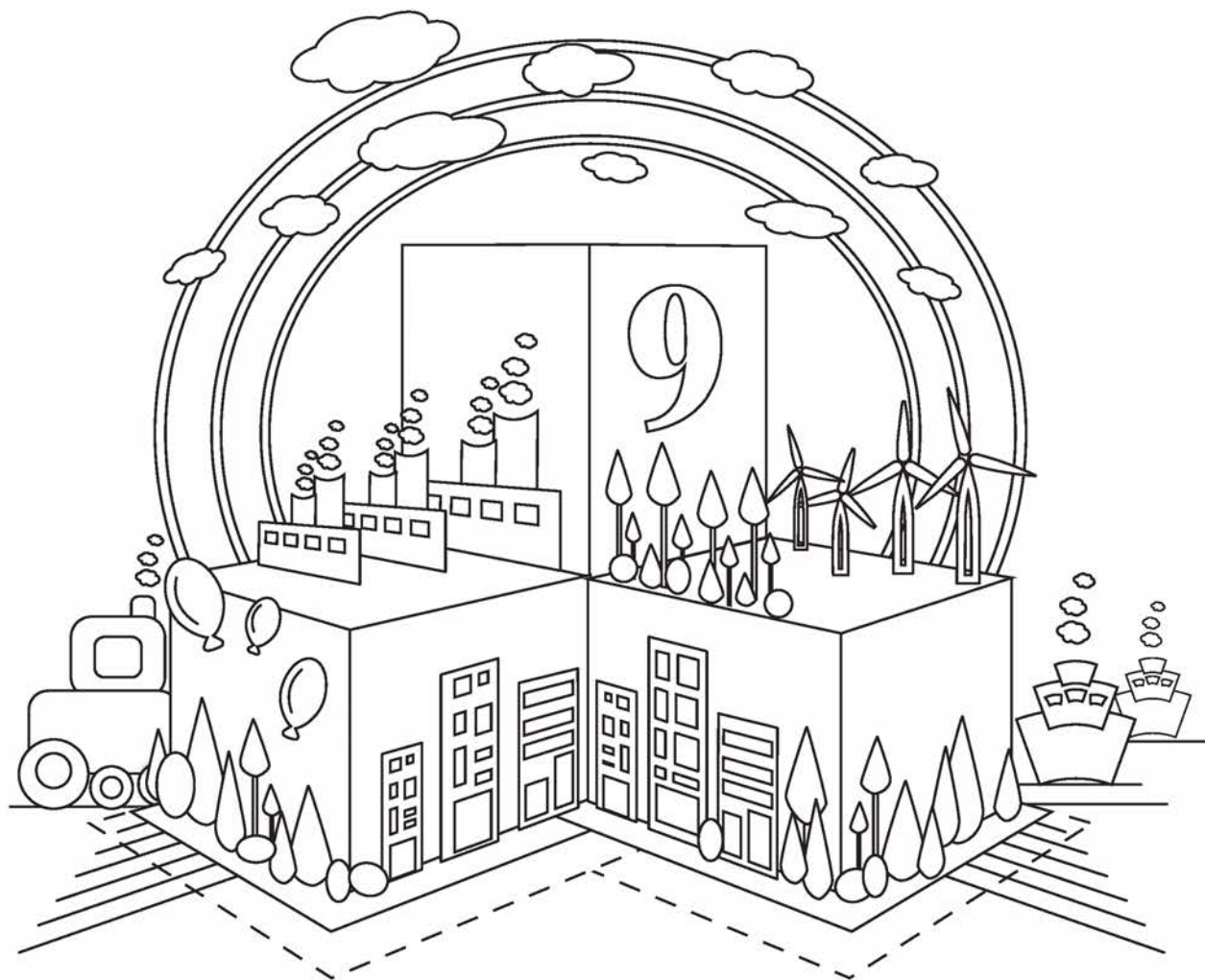




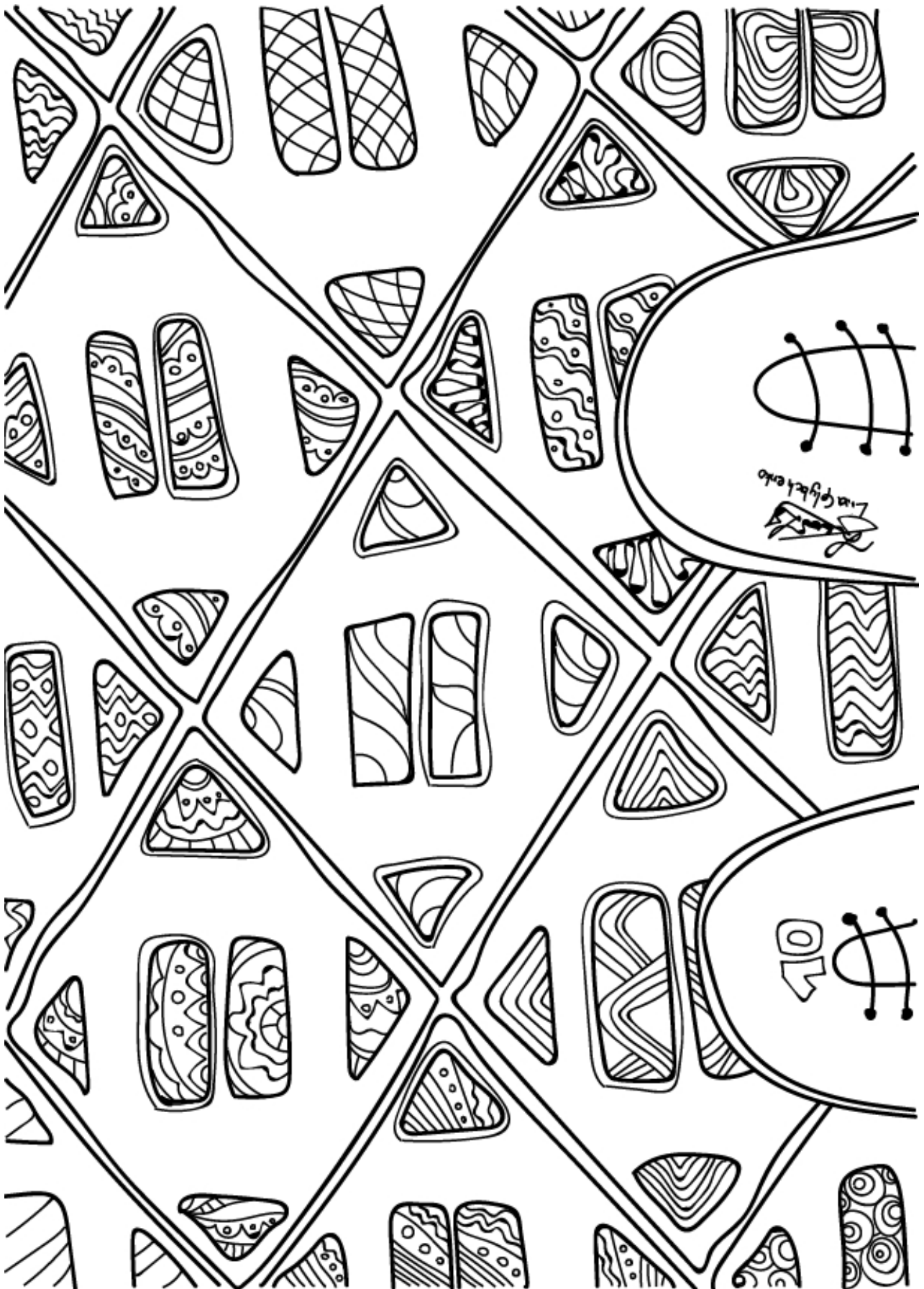








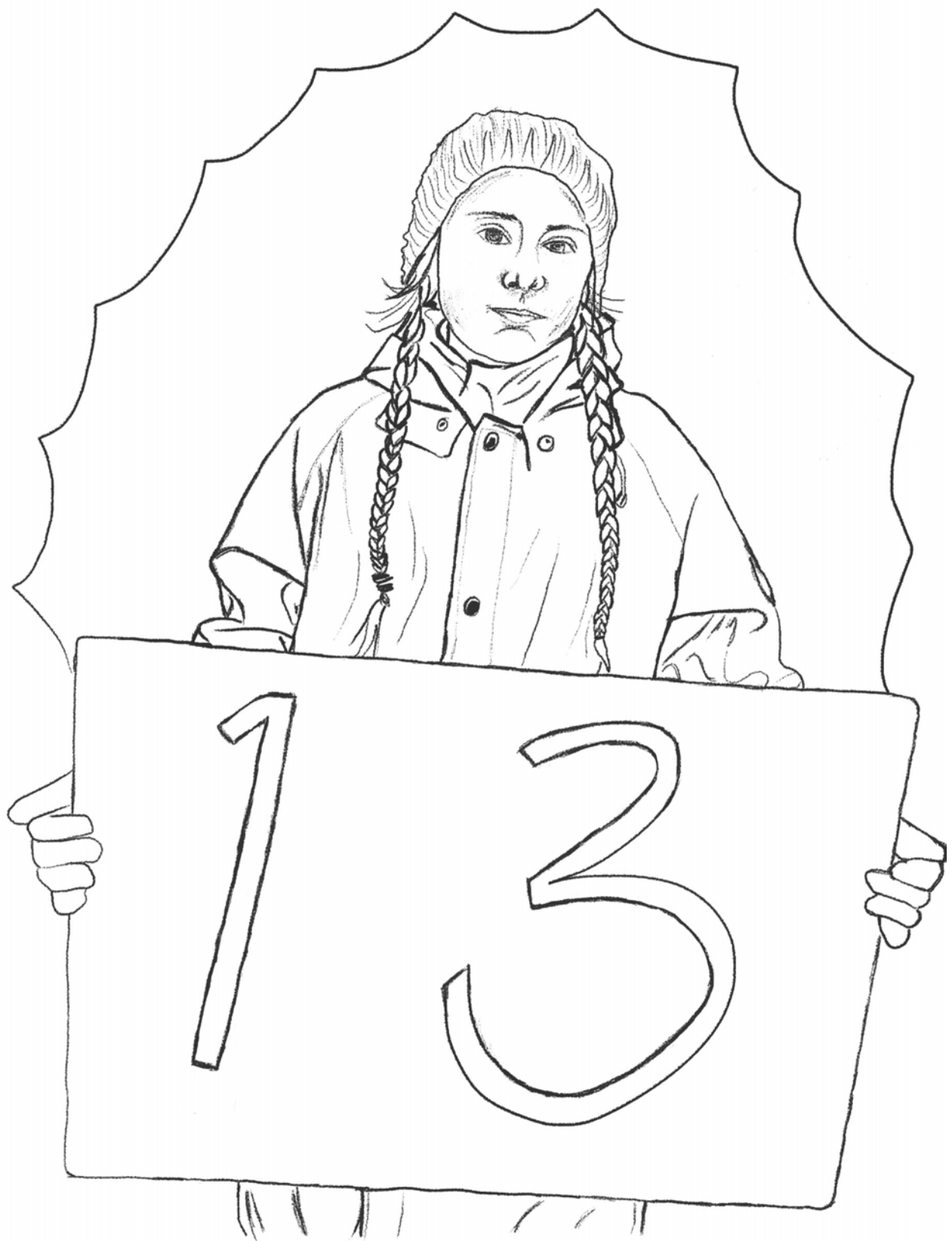


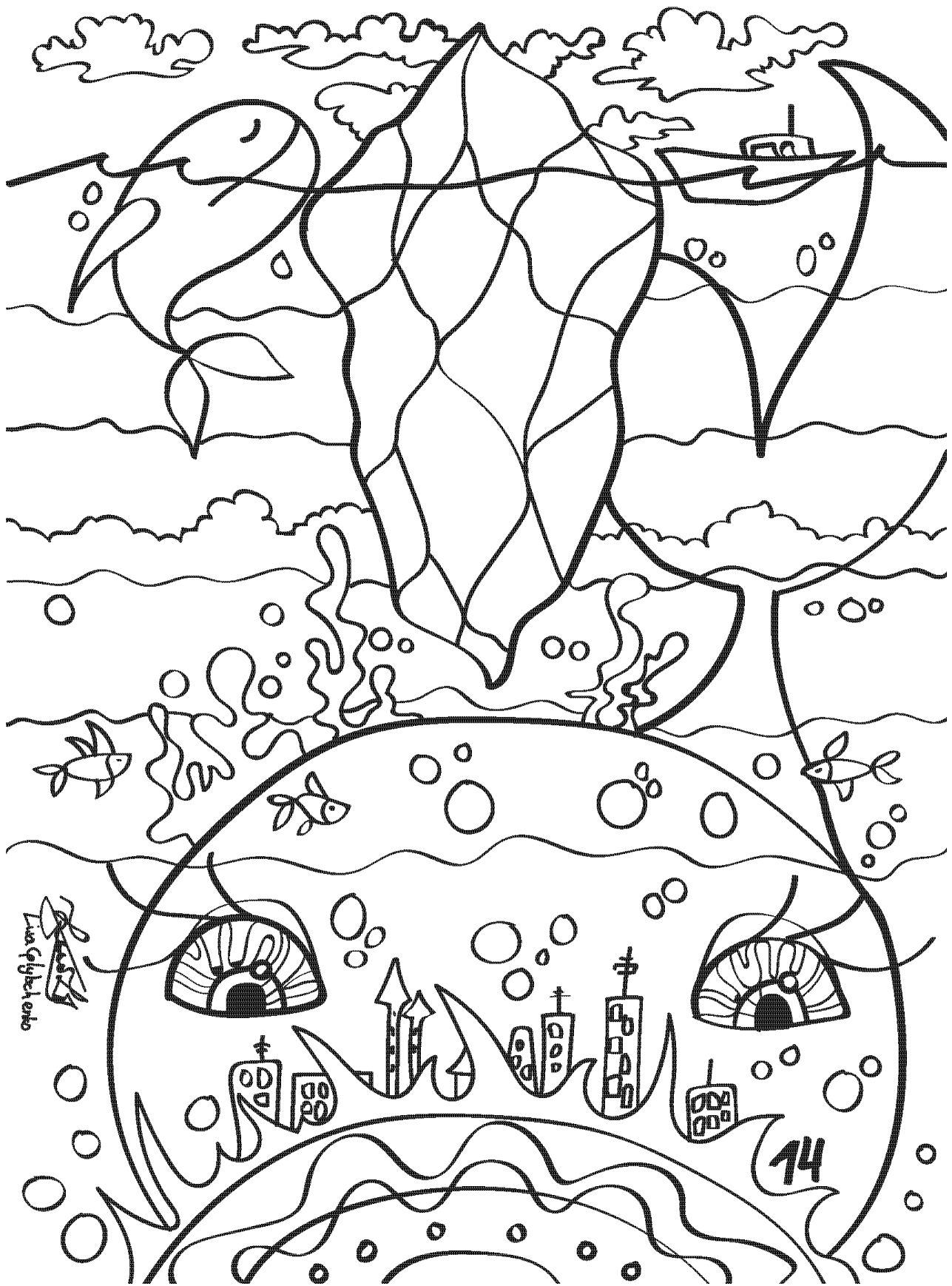










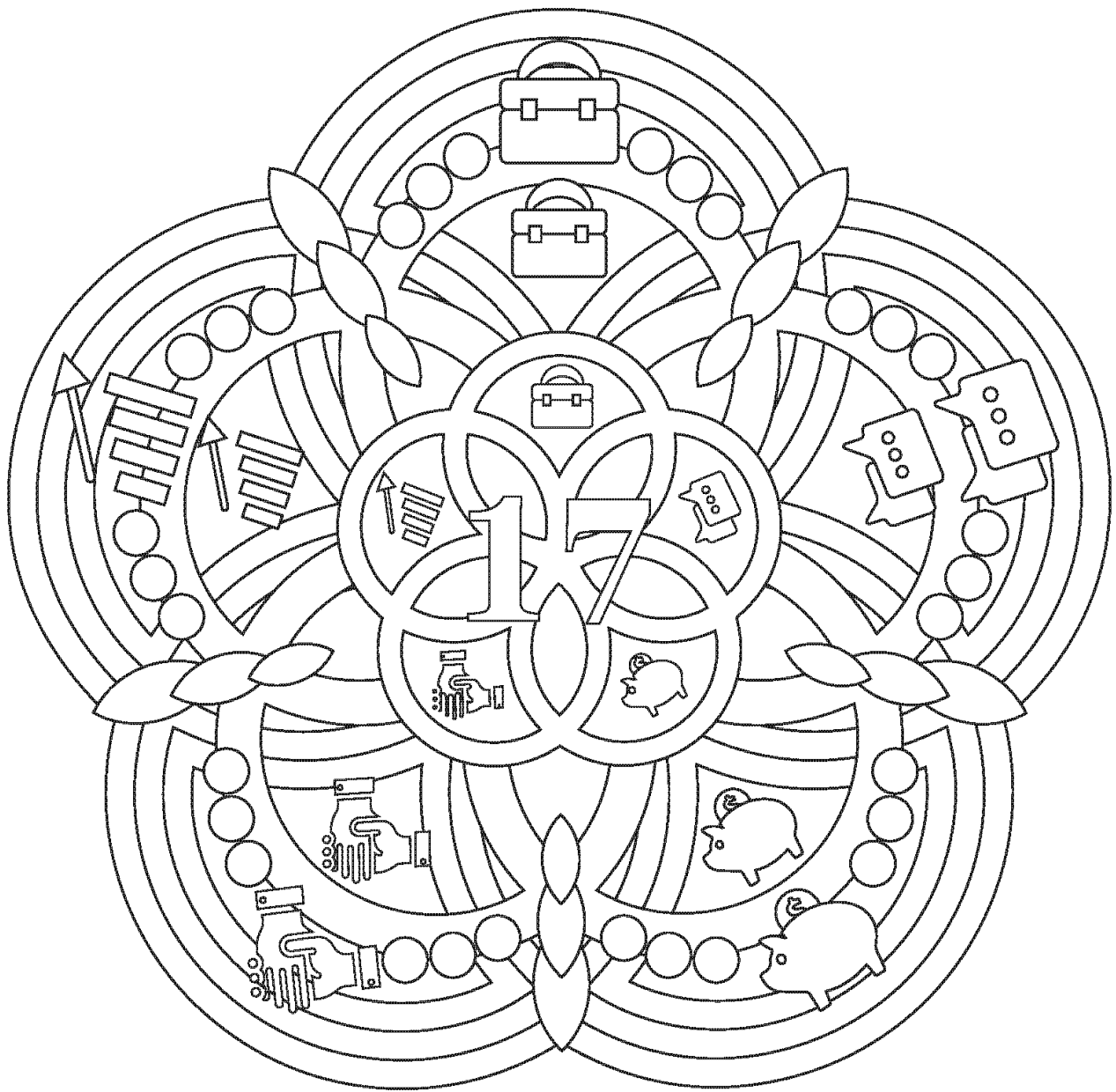












## ILLUSTRATORS

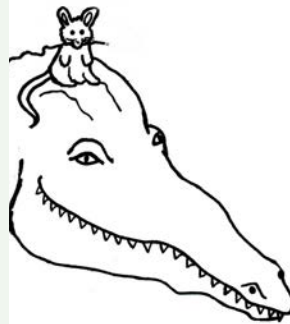
